

TYHP Booth Volunteer Guidelines

Thank you for volunteering to represent the Texas Youth Hunting Program (TYHP) at an event! Your role is essential in helping spread awareness about our program, recruiting new volunteers, and finding landowners willing to host youth hunts. Below are some key guidelines to help you effectively engage with event attendees.

Preparing for the Event

- Confirm booth details with TYHP staff and event organizers.
- **Request marketing materials** in advance! Please give the TYHP office staff **at least two weeks notice** to mail brochures, landowner packets, and other exhibit materials.
- **Review TYHP information** beforehand so you can confidently answer questions.

Engaging with Visitors

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- **Be proactive!** If someone lingers near the booth, start a conversation. Ask, "*Are you interested in youth hunting?*" or "*Have you heard about our program?*"
- Highlight TYHP opportunities for different audiences:
 - Youth: Hunting opportunities.
 - Adults: Ways to get involved as a volunteer Huntmaster or support staff, including:
 - Cooking
 - Range coordination
 - Hunter safety and skills instruction
 - Hunt guiding
 - General assistance

Who We're Looking For

- Landowners willing to donate youth hunts. Provide them with a landowner packet and explain that TYHP can assist with insurance, supplies, and food.
- Volunteers to help make these hunts possible.
